My dear Mr. Leubuscher:

An institute or school chartered by the Regents may issue certificates without seeking the consent of said Board, since the issuance of certificates is not restricted by legal statute or by department rules. The certificate of "alertness" to which you refer in your letter of October 13 is a matter between you and the Board of Education of the City of New York. Sometimes the Board of Education refer such matters to this Department for our approval. In case such a request for approval came to this office, it is difficult for me to state at this time whether or not we would be able to approve the work you are conducting as satisfying the requirements of the "alertness rule" of the Board of Education.
