To the Fourth Annual Henry George Congress,
Pennsylvania Hotel, New York City,
Greeting:

This is to advise that at a regular meeting of the Executive Council of this Corporation held Sept 6th, the following resolutions were unanimously adopted:

Resolved, that in lieu of our Secretary, E. B. Gaston, who was invited to participate in the approaching Henry George Congress at New York, by appearing on the program to present the subject, "The Success of the Singletax Enclaves" but who finds it inconvenient to do so Mr. Albert E. Schalkenbach be and is appointed as our official representative at the Congress, and the program committee be requested to give him the place assigned Mr. Gaston on the program.

Resolved further, that Mr. Schalkenbach be asked to present our most cordial greeting to the Congress; to say that we rejoice in his and heartily approve the purpose of the Henry George Foundation to be "One Great Brotherhood to popularize and attain the Single Tax" and that we wish to hold fellowship with all who cherish the truth proclaimed by Henry George and work for the same by whatever method most appeals to them.

Resolved further, that he be asked to extend to all a cordial invitation to visit Fairhope and learn at first hand, of our method for immediate application of the Single Tax principle.
