The daughter of Leo Tolstoy, Alexandra, died September 26 at the age of 95, at the Tolstoy Foundation in Valley Cottage, New York. Deeply committed to her father's philosophy, she also endorsed his acceptance of Henry George's philosophy (see Winter 1979 GJ), and had spoken on occasion at Georgist events. She founded the Tolstoy Foundation to aid refugees from Soviet Russia.
