

GLOSSARY

- **abdicate**—To give up a throne or other position of power.
- Cortes—The parliament, or legislature, of Spain.
- **coup**—An overthrow of a government by force.
- **Criollo**—A person of Spainish descent born in Latin America.
- **depression**—A period of decline in a country's economy, causing business failures and unemployment.
- **émigré**—A person forced to leave his country for political reasons.
- **exile**—A forced separation from one's country. A person who is forced to leave his own country and live in another.
- **filibuster**—An irregular military operation, usually undertaken without approval of government.
- **grito**—A shout or cry. A name for a political declaration or a call to action.



- **guerrilla**—A member of a band of soldiers who operate outside of a military organization.
- **junta**—A small group of people who take over a country after a revolution or overthrow of a government.
- **liberal**—A person who favors progress or reform in politics.
- lyceum—A lecture hall.
- **manifesto**—A declaration of purposes or intentions.
- **peninsular**—A person who is born in Spain but lives in Latin America.
- **underground**—An organization or army that operates in secret.
- **voluntario**—A member of a group attached to or working for the Spanish army or militia.
