Justice Longfield (Britain):

"Property in land differs in its origin from property in any commodity produced by human labour; the product of labour naturally belongs t the labourer who produced it, but the same argument does not apply to land which is not p;roduced by labour, but is the gift of the Creator of the world to mankind; every argument used to give an ethical foundation for the exclusive right of private property has a latent fallacy."
