HENRY (HARRY) TIDEMAN, RIP June 30, 1911 - July 24, 1987

It is with sorrow that we report the death of our colleague and friend, Mr. Henry Tideman. He died peacefully at home after a long illness.

Mr. Tideman was a third generation Georgist. He learned Henry George's philosophy from his father and grandfather long before he read "Progress and Poverty". He was associated with the Henry George School from its 1934 inception in Chicago. He was a charter member and vice-president in the 1970 reorganization, served as president in 1974 and 1975, and continued as a valued member of the Board until his death.

Henry Tideman was an architect by profession. He received his degree from the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana. Henry worked at his profession until the terminal illness prevented him. He was last with Lester B. Knight & Associates in Chicago. His architectural works won him many awards, fellowships and prizes.

Henry is survived by his widow, Jean, and children Henry Jr. (Dawn), Susan, Dorian Stock and Jennifer Stock; a brother Robert (Meighan), in San Francisco, and sister Dorothy (Charles) Bradsher, in Timberlake, North Carolina; three grandchildren and numerous nephews and nieces.
