Daniel Carter Beard, artist, author; member of a family of artists. Son of late James H. Beard, National Academician; brother of Frank Beard, editor of Ram's Horn and cartoonist; brother of J. Carter Beard, illustrator. Born in Cincinnati, June 21, 1850; graduate World's Academy. Covington, Ky., 1868-1869; studied civil engineering under Gen. Hickenloper, of Cincinnati. Afterwards member of the city engineering staff, Cincinnati; later with Sanborn Publishing Co. of N. Y; opened studio in New York, 1878, where he worked in the daytime and studied at the Art Students' League at night; Member of the Society of Illustrators; author: Moonblight and Six Feet of Romance, an economic novel on the Single Tax plan; American Boys' Handybook; Jack of All Trades; Outdoor Handybook. Editor, Recreation Magazine; associate editor, Arena; contributor to various prominent magazines; member of Board of Education, Flushing, L. I.; president Flushing Single Tax Club; worked through the Henry George campaigns; personal friend of Henry George and Dr. McGlynn.
