approach we are taking is, we believe, far more likely to generate influence because of the targeted distribution being made. The rapidly changing circumstances in the former Soviet Union is the focus of our first *Forum*, which has been mailed to over 800 individuals (including more than 100 economists and policy analysts in Russia). I am happy to include this material for your review and comment. With your concurrence, we will add you to the list of recipients so that you are kept informed of our progress.

The enormity of the challenge we face in working for constructive and peaceful changes in our socio-political arrangements and institutions has not abated over the decades. There are few enough of us who have come to understand the consequence of practices that sanction the monopolization of locations and natural resources. I have taken this opportunity to apprise you of the School's initiatives with the hope that a new and production relationship might develop between us.
